



Minimum Enrolment Criteria

Technical training on CONCEPT products is primarily intended for electronic security Technicians. Subsequently, the basic entry level Installation and Programming course requires that prospective students have at least a working knowledge of basic security alarm systems and cabling.

This document specifies the experience and competencies that potential students should possess prior to attending even the most basic of Inner Range Training courses.

Enrolment requires that the participant:

1. Has actually installed an alarm system his or her self.
2. Has commissioned an alarm system through to a Central Monitoring Station.
3. Can describe the purpose of an End-of-line resistor.
4. Can describe the purpose of a Tamper switch.
5. Can describe the differences between a “Normally Open” Device and a “Normally Closed” Device.
6. Can describe the purpose of entry delay zones and handover or follow zones.
7. Can describe the difference between an 8 ohm siren and a 12 volt siren.
8. Has a general understanding of Ohm’s Law and can calculate one of the values, given the values of the other two variables.
9. Can calculate the power requirements of the system to be installed and determine the suitability or constraints of the proposed Power Supply.
